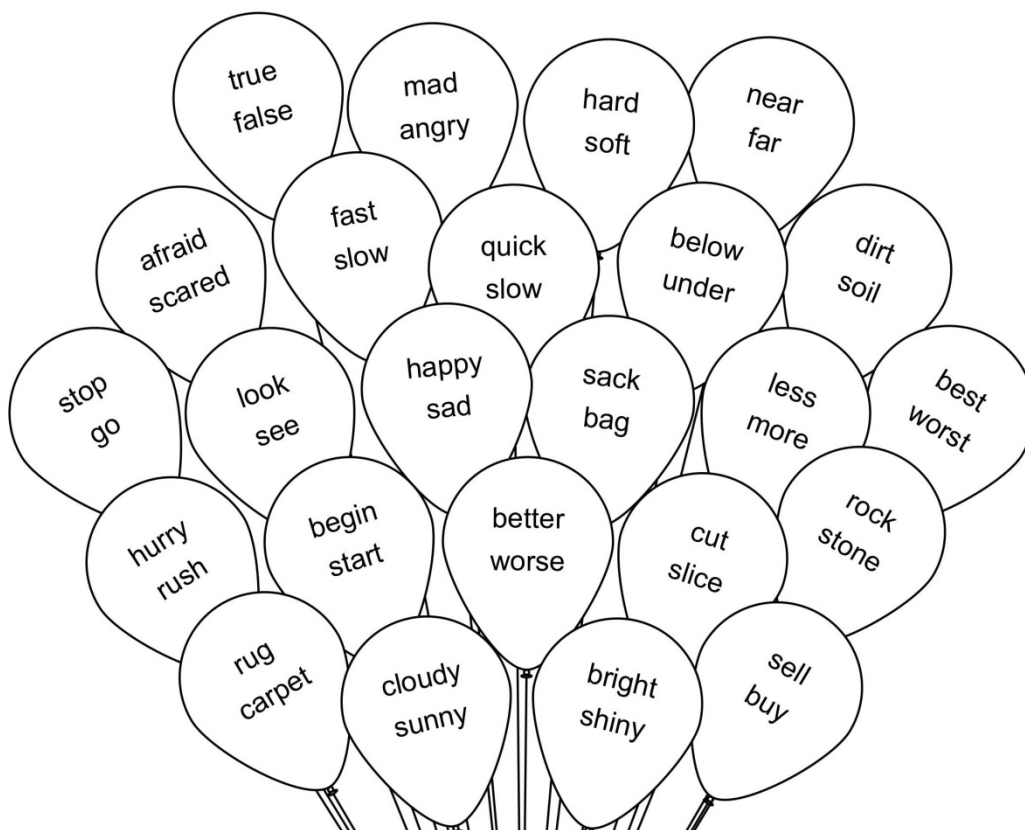
day the people of Makkah would drive Muhammed ﷺ out of Makkah.

THE FINAL MESSENGER ﷺ

Lesson: 10

Khadijah رضي الله عنها was the first to accept Islam. *Islam is to submit to Allah alone and to worship Him alone without joining any partners with him.*

Muhammed صلى الله عليه وسلم freed slave, Zaid رضي الله عنه, his best friend Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه, and his cousin Ali رضي الله عنه all accepted Islam. They then called their families and friends to accept Islam.

All those who worship Allah alone and follow his Messenger Muhammed صلى الله عليه وسلم are called Muslims.

In the early days of revelation, Muhammed صلى الله عليه وسلم thought the Muslims about Allah and Islam in secret from a house owned by Al Arqam. He warned the Muslims to stay away from the Quraish who did not accept Islam and worshipped idols.

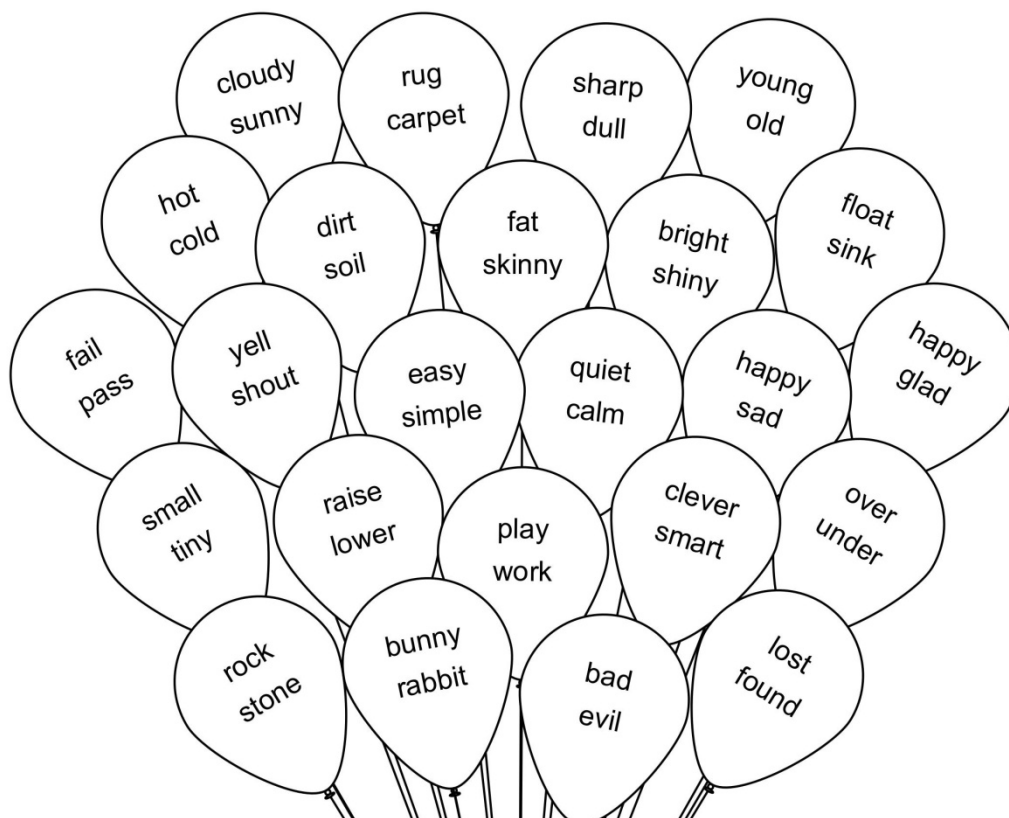
