The Ka'bah was built by two prophets, Ibrahim عليه and his son Ismaeel عليه السّلام.



Abdul Muttalib was overjoyed and named the boy Muhammed صلّی الله علیه و سلّم.


Muhammed صلّی الله علیه و سلّم and his family were descendants of Prophet Ibrahim علیه through his son Ismaeel السّلام.

After many months of drought, the rains came down and soon there was plenty of food and water for the sheep, camels and for Haleemah رضي الله عنها s whole family.


Life in the desert was good for the babies as there was fresh air, water and plenty of space for them to run around.



made of wood and stone which the Quraish worshipped. Muhammed صلّی الله علیه و سلّم loved Allah and knew that these idols could not help or protect his people.



They were happily married and had two sons and four daughters. His sons and daughters died before him, except for Fatimah رضي الله عنها.





The incident was so scary for Muhammed صلّی الله علیه و that he ran home in a hurry to Khadijah سلّم and said "Cover me! Cover me!"





Khadijah رضي الله عنها was the first to accept Islam. *Islam* is to submit to Allah alone and to worship Him alone without joining any partners with him.

رضي الله freed slave, Zaid صلّى الله عليه و سلّم freed slave, Zaid عنه, his best friend Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه, and his cousin Ali رضي الله عنه all accepted Islam. They then called their families and friends to accept Islam.

All those who worship Allah alone and follow his Messenger Muhammed صرآنی الله علیه و سلّم are called Muslims.

In the early days of revelation, Muhammed وسلّم thought the Muslims about Allah and Islam in secret from a house owned by Al Arqam. He warned the Muslims to stay away from the Quraish who did not accept Islam and worshipped idols.

There were many idols surrounding the Ka'bah, the House of Allah that was built only for the worship of Allah by the Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام and his son Ismaeel عليه السلام.


