



## Lesson 27



<u>Note</u>: If this letter has *fatḥah*, *kasrah* or *dammah* it is pronounced like consonant, i.e. as *wa*, *wi*, *wu*.

This letter is pronounced by bringing the corners of the mouth together. It should not be pronounced like the English  $\nu$  which is pronounced with the upper teeth coming in contact with the lower lip.
