




One morning, as dawn was breaking, Muhammed صلّی stood on a nearby mountain called As Safa and called out loudly "Ya Sabahah"


Khadijah رضي الله عنها was the first to accept Islam. *Islam* is to submit to Allah alone and to worship Him alone without joining any partners with him.

رضي الله freed slave, Zaid صلّى الله عليه و سلّم freed slave, Zaid عنه , his best friend Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه , and his cousin Ali رضي الله عنه all accepted Islam. They then called their families and friends to accept Islam.

All those who worship Allah alone and follow his Messenger Muhammed صلّی الله علیه و سلّم are called Muslims.

الله عليه thought the Muslims about Allah and Islam in secret from a house owned by Al Arqam. He warned the Muslims to stay away from the Quraish who did not accept Islam and worshipped idols.

There were many idols surrounding the Ka'bah, the House of Allah that was built only for the worship of Allah by the Prophet Ibrahim عليه السلام and his son Ismaeel عليه السلام.







Allah guided Muhammed صلّی الله علیه و سلّم from a very young age. So, he kept away from the Quraish who disobeyed Allah.


Muhammed صلّى الله عليه و سلّم always loved to visit his favorite cave in the mountain of Hira. There he would remember Allah and count on all his blessings.




